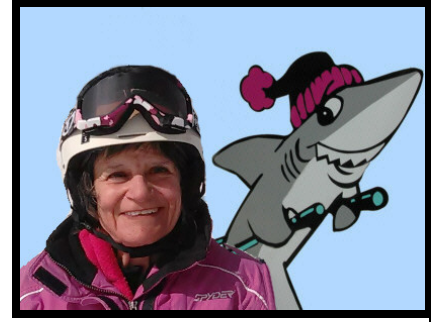

Join Steve and Cindy for a fabulous ski trip to enjoy Utah's Champagne Powder. You'll have the daily choice between Powder Mountain and Snowbasin Ski Resorts. Both resorts get plenty of fluffy powder and have very few skiers.

Powder Mountain (POWMOW) has 8,000 acres of terrain (2,600 acres bigger than Vail), is rustic and all about the skiing from groomed cruising to fabulous powder on steeps and in a wonderland of trees. POWMOW has a quest to "Preserve the Snow" and by limiting the skiers to 2,000 per day, and they mean it. Skiing is free for folks 75 or over.

Snowbasin has 3,000 acres, was built for the 2002 Winter Olympics and has some of the most luxurious lodges and amenities in Utah. This year Ski Magazine ranked Snowbasin Resort #4 in Lifts, #5 in Service and #6 in grooming. It is truly the 'Mega resort without the Mega lines'. You'll be able to spread your ski days between these resorts or every day at one. The initial and prime attraction of this trip was all about the quality of the skiing.

We will be staying at the Courtyard Marriott in downtown Ogden. The hotel rooms have the choice of 1 king size bed or 2 doubles, microwave, mini fridge, free internet, full hot breakfast and convenient ski storage. The pickup for either ski resort is conveniently located in front of the hotel; you will be at either resort within 30 minutes.

Our Courtyard is located so close to historic 25th Street where the features of Ogden become apparent. Ogden has plenty of restaurants, night life, 3 craft breweries, a distillery and other neat downtown stuff. Folks that like to take a day off from skiing will find the Union Station Museum fascinating. It's mostly about the First Transcontinental Railroad which culminated with The Golden Spike being driven in the Promontory Mountains near the edge of The Great Salt Lake. Kids of all ages will be captivated by the many model trains. The history of Browning Arms is included with a sample of almost everything Browning ever produced. Your appreciation for the movement west of our country will be greatly enhanced.
