The Crestwood Condominiums are a 1 ½ hour bus ride from the airport and provide true Snowmass ski in/ski out access. They are located conveniently between Snowmass Mall and Snowmass Base Village right off the Fanny Hill trail. The location allows you to get on and off the slopes and back to your condo effortlessly, while enjoying a luxurious atmosphere and top notch amenities.

The Crestwood is beautifully furnished and decorated. Each unit includes a fully equipped kitchen, dining seating, cable TV, high-speed Wi-Fi and gas fireplace in the living room, perfect for relaxing in front of after a satisfying day on the slopes. Take in the views from your private balcony or use the outdoor gas BBQ grill. Other amenities include an outdoor heated pool, three hot tubs, fitness center, steam room, sauna, complimentary laundry facilities, grocery and liquor shopping and delivery, ski rentals, storage and tuning, onsite massage and spa treatments.



**The Mountains:** You can choose from 4 different mountains with your interchangeable lift tickets. All 4 resorts are within 9 miles via free/convenient ski busses giving you access to 5500 combined skiing/snowboarding acres.

**Snowmass** - One can spend an entire trip exploring Snowmass and never ski the same run twice. Snowmass has 21 lifts, 94 trails on 3,332 acres offering skiing/boarding runs for all abilities. From the gentle dips and drops of Elk Camp to the wide open cruising trails on the Big Burn to the aggressive, double-black-diamond runs of Hanging Valley, it is easy to see why Snowmass is among the top rated ski areas in North America! 5% Green, 48% Blue, 17% Black Diamond, 30% Double Black Diamond.

**Aspen** - This is where it all began some 70 years ago. From the beginning "Ajax" is still one incredible mountain to explore. It is ideal for intermediate to expert skill levels as it offers some of the most challenging trails in the world. From the steep, gladed runs of the "Dumps", to the incredible bumps on Ruthie's Run, Aspen Mountain is truly the athlete's dream. Aspen has 8 lifts, 76 trails on 675 acres, 0% Green, 48% Blue, 26% Black Diamond, 26% Double Black Diamond.

**Aspen Highlands** - This resort has always been a local's favorite with uncrowded slopes, terrific views, a friendly atmosphere, exciting and diverse terrain. There's something for everyone here from the gentle beginning slopes, the beautiful intermediate cruising terrain, to the more challenging Steeplechase. Aspen Highlands is a multi-faceted area with terrain to satisfy skiers/boarders of all levels. Locals love its hidden stash of powder and the pristine runs of Highland Bowl. Expert skiers flock to their pick of the steeps off the Deep Temerity lift. There are several brilliant cruisers mid-mountain for intermediates. Not to be missed are the unobstructed views of the famous Maroon Bells, while dining on fondue and raclette at the Cloud Nine Alpine Bistro. Aspen Highlands has 5 lifts, 144 trails on 1,040 acres, 0% Green, 23% Blue, 12% Black Diamond, 65% Double Black Diamond.

**Buttermilk** is the home of the ESPN Winter X Games through 2019 - Buttermilk has a dual personality. On one hand it is designed primarily for learning and improving your technique on long and easy runs, with scenic views of nearby Pyramid Peak. Boarders can check out the great bumps on Sterner or learn how to ski the trees in Timber Doodle Glades, or drop into the 22 foot Superpipe. Buttermilk has earned the **#1 ranking** for a fourth consecutive year from Transworld Snowboarding Magazine. The Hideout, Buttermilk's new children's center will inspire children to enjoy mountain adventure and explore new challenges. If you are looking to start out easy ... or looking to be the next big thing in freestyle skiing and riding, Buttermilk is the place to be. Locals head for the black runs on Buttermilk, especially on powder days - one of Aspen's best-kept secrets. Buttermilk has 8 lifts, 44 trails on 470 acres, 35% Green, 39% Blue, 21% Black Diamond, 5% Double Black Diamond
